COMMITTEE:	STUDENT ACTIVITY
MEETING SIZE:	Open
MEMBERSHIP:	Chairperson, Co-Chairperson and members appointed by the President. It is recommended that there be one representative from each of the Universities and Technical schools with academic programs in water environment in addition to other members.
CHARGE:	<p>The Committee shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Plan and carry out programs and activities aimed at student participation in the Association and the Federation.<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Student Design Competitionb.2) Coordination with the Intermountain Section of AWWA is important in this effort.
REPORT:	A report should be submitted to the President at or prior to the Annual Meeting which summarizes the year's activities and accomplishments.
WEFTec Student Design:	<p>The student team selected to go to WEFTec will receive a stipend of \$1,000 per student up to five students; with a cap of \$5,000 for the team.</p> <p>WEAU Board will not gathering receipts and will not entertain expenses beyond the \$1,000 stipend. There will not be any additional for advisors, parents, more expensive air plane tickets, etc.</p> <p>To attend the annual conference to practice, only the registration fee will be covered. There will be no additional.</p> <p>If needed, the Board will help pick topics for the student design.</p>
ANNUAL CONFERENCE:	<p>Students will be invited to attend the annual conference to present the student design. Registration to the annual conference will be free to the students as they register as a student on the association's website. The student will be responsible for their travel and lodging accommodations.</p>
